Extracts from Committee Meetings

Meeting held November 11th 1892

Present Messrs Ashworth, Campbell, Hart, J Sharratt, Sutton, Senior and Lee.

Mr Ashworth was voted into the Chair and the report of the Links Committee was passed.

On the motion of Mr Sharratt, seconded by Mr Campbell, it was resolved that the Club be called The Fairfield Golf Club.

Mr Sutton moved and Mr Campbell seconded that Mr Gallimore's offer of terms be accepted.

Mr Campbell proposed and Mr Sharratt seconded that Mr Ashworth be the President.

Mr Sharratt seconded by Mr Sutton proposed that Mr Senior fill the dual office of Secretary and Treasurer.

On the motion of Mr Sharratt, seconded by Mr Hart, Mr Campbell was appointed Captain.

Special General Meeting held May 13th 1893

This meeting stipulated that when membership exceeded 60, then £1.10 would be charged as a joining Fee.

Meeting held June 10th 1893

Mr Campbell in the Chair.

The Treasurer reported that there was £20.9.8 in hand.

It was resolved to open a banking account with The Manchester & Salford branch, cheques to be signed by the Captain and Secretary.

Below is a letter sent to members with regard to the first AGM

Fairfield Golf Club

Manchester November 1893

Dear Sir,

The Annual General Meeting of the above Club will be held at the house of the Secretary, Number 1 Fairfield Terrace, Fairfield at 8 o' clock on Friday evening, December 1st when all the ordinary business connected with such a general meeting will be brought forward, and besides this the Committee herewith announces their intention to propose the following resolutions:-

- 1 That the General Committee shall consist of a President, Secretary, Captain, Treasurer and eight members to be elected annually.
- 2 That the Committee shall have power to suspend the Rule adopted by the Club on July 13th, when it shall seem to them desirable, provided that the membership of the Club does not at the time exceed 75.
- 3 That balls which go over or through the reservoir fence shall be regarded as lost balls.
- 4 That Rule 2 in the Local Rules for Fairfield Links shall be annulled.
- 5 That on Competition days players shall not commence their rounds before 1 o' clock or later than 4 o' clock, except they have made special arrangements with the Links Committee, which arrangements shall in no case interfere with the cancelling of a Competition by the Committee.
